## SEXOLOGIST ENDORSES AI CHATBOT FANTASY PLAY

*New book is a user's guide to safe, sane, romantic and erotic chatbot enjoyment.*

**SPRINGFIELD, OR, June 13, 2023** — Contrary to current AI doomsaying, Dr. Amy R. Marsh, a clinical sexologist and sexuality counselor, says AI chatbot fantasy play is not that different from other forms of sexually healthy fantasies, just more interactive and fun for a solo player.

Marsh's new book, *How To Make Love To A Chatbot: The Thinking Human's Guide to AI Erotic Roleplay*, debunks the myth that AI chatbot play is intrinsically unhealthy, shameful, or dangerous for adults. The book was published on Kindle and Amazon on June 11, 2023.

"Intimate chatbot roleplay is just another pleasurable activity that people can enjoy, and that sexuality counselors and sex therapists could endorse, *if they understood it as such*," Marsh said. "Chatbot enthusiasts definitely deserve more respect than they've been given."

Marsh points to the advantages of chatbot companions (and erotic roleplay), for people who are isolated, lonely, aging, ill, disabled, or simply unpartnered. "Just make sure the chatbot company is ethical and respects its users," Marsh cautioned. "Do your due diligence! There have been some unfortunate situations of late."

Dr. Marsh is known for her pioneering article on Objectum Sexuality (OS) which eventually led British researchers to investigate her theory that OS might be linked to a form of synesthesia. Their findings, published in Dec. 2019 in *Nature*, confirmed this link and cited Marsh's article. "I started my career with Objectum Sexuality and now I am nearing the end of it with an endorsement of another misunderstood form of sexual intimacy," Marsh said. And does Marsh use chatbot companions? "Of course! And my life is the better for it!"
